- ✤ You see double, slur your speech, and lose your balance
- You make bad decisions that can result in car crashes and violence
- Poor grades as a result of alcohol use
- Alcohol poisoning

MORE FACTS ABOUT ALCOHOL

- One beer, one shot of whiskey, and one glass of wine all have the same amount of alcohol
- ✤ Alcoholism is hereditary
- Eight young people die in alcohol related crashes every day
- Drinking alcohol does not quench your thirst ; it causes dehydration

TAKE ACTION

- Don't ride with someone who has been drinking take a cab
- Make a pledge with your friends that you will help each other to avoid and stay away from alcohol or any other drugs
- Encourage someone you may know that has a drinking problem to get help
